RDA Program Manager- Tim Sexton

Lisa for Tim: We want feedback on how things are going in the field using WFDSS for decisions and Analysis. AK- things working relatively well in AK. Jeremy in UT, things generally ok but getting weird stuff and will get with Lisa offline. As a reminder if you have issues please send them in through feedback so that we can log/track them. Emerging Issues- All Call Participants

- Tree Mortality data for Southern Sierras as WFDSS Unit Shapes- Amy Ziegler. R5 has loaded tree mortality data as unit shapes for 3 forests so that 1) decision makers can see it on the map screen with other data info in WFDSS 2) analyst can use the shapes for edits in modeling manipulation. They used the ADS data and broke it out by phase (age essentially, red, grey, older) and severity of trees per acre affected. Shapes buffered by 15 miles and generalized to reduce complexity so it would load. There is a current fire in one of these areas and the shapes are working well/ of good use.

WFDSS Quick Tip – Ben Butler

- My Home: My Incidents, My Activities, Map Bookmarks, Messages
 - My home: Reminder that there are 4 tabs, the first gives incident that are relevant to you, in which you are part of the incident contacts, also there is system preferences here that you can change around, you can change the base map layers. My activities is a list of things you could recently link to: downloads, decisions, analysis. My bookmarks are very useful to bookmark situation, analysis maps, intel maps, you can link to them. And messages, this is a place where system messages are stored, such as password expiration times, alerts.

WFDSS Updates - Mitch Burgard & Marlena Hovorka

- WFDSS Update
 - Recently have updated the ArcGis this should make the models more stable and faster.
 - There have been a few UI changes for wording changes.
 - Still trying to get criterion up to speed on the system and will continue to try to move ahead suggestions when we have an opportunity.
 - Reminder that we have a lot of contractors that work in WFDSS and its important for GAEs to verify their legit use, examples include ADs, state, country as editors, fire behavior specialist, etc.
 - There is a text limit on decision editor but no pop up indicating that you have hit the limit so it just cuts text off and user doesn't know. A pop up has been added to training and will be pushed to production soon to help avoid this issue.



- Frequently received Helpdesk questions
 - NTFB slow, but seems to be getting better. We do try to track the analysis que to see if things are slow, but without looking at each of the inputs for runs it's hard to know if things are unusually slow and a problem is occurring so please send in feedback if you think your runs are not processing fast enough.

- IRWIN Status
 - IRWIN prod site has been very stable, the dev side has been testing a lot of info lately so WFDSS dev disconnected to the Irwin dev sever but will reconnect again soon. IRWIN V4 changes are focused on IA resource data and implementing changes from complexes and mergers. A data exchange summit is possibly the week of Oct. 3rd in coordination with an NWCG meeting. Gabriella Branson has stepped down from IRWIN effort, IDEAS group may be in flux as a result, will have Gwenan update the GAEs if she has info next call.
