### WFDSS Updates - Mitch Burgard & Marlana Hovorka

- Status of WFDSS contract transition
  - Criterion was officially awarded the contract,
    - Providing the O and M side of the application
    - IBM was extended to due some O am M work, 508 work, software updates that needed to be complete
    - Shadowing IBM to learn the application through April, Formal takeover is May 1
    - Trying to get some development enhancements in the que BUT they will not occur until the fall after the field season
- Frequently received helpdesk questions
  - Nothing really to report, pretty quiet still
- Continue to provide feedback on how to update/improve WFDSS despite not having the ability to do enhancements until the fall

### IRWIN Status – Andrew Bailey

- Status
  - Winding down IRWIN development phase for 2016
  - Integration testing event in SLC Early February

- 80 instances of issues they were able to fix or become aware of
  - WFDSS should be done this time around
  - IRWIN release team has been asked to attend the Dispatch workshops
    - Prineville, Wenatchee and SE area to assist with development hardware and testing
    - Any questions please direct this too Andrew
  - March 30 version 3 will go live
- Volunteers for IRWIN User Community Group
  - Data exchanges user group
    - To help fix/identify projects
    - Would like 2 volunteers from a WFDSS perspective,
      - **Need 1 volunteer** from this group as a minimum

### Geospatial Data – Andrew Bailey/Ben Butler

- FMU/Strategic Objective shapes update
  - Received 7 different data sets
  - Off to IBM by the 24<sup>th</sup> of February
  - March 16 is the next due date to have information to Ben/Andrew... remember your agency GIS person will have an earlier due date
- Data refresh for February
  - 3 additional data layers updated
    - Wilderness, critical habitat, administrative boundaries, buildings, fuel treatments and roads
- Deep Dive webinars, Feb. 25<sup>th</sup> @ 1300 MT and March 3<sup>rd</sup> at 1000 MT
  - 103 folks have registered thus far... 1 ½ in length

  - Firenet is potentially going to give relief but that is still a long term goal

- 14-5/14-6: DOA/Leaders Intent and WFDSS
  - Lisa updated previously on the call
- 15-3: Usage of states in WFDSS
  - In progress the data fields within SQL weren't allowing us to pull the data in a useable manner
- 15-4: Strategy Slider in WFDSS- complete
  - Morgan sent this with the agenda, she will present this at the Portland Conference
- 15-6: AA Spring webinars
  - Identified the dates etc earlier in the call
- 15-12: FBS and ensuring the operation within their quals/ knowing what their quals are
  - Still discussing the concerns with the situation once a person completes 495 they automatically are given GSAF qualifier - which is a tech specialist
  - More or a mentoring program is needed
  - What needs to be done from this point forward?
    - Building better awareness in the fire community
    - FBS/495 will follow up on where we need to go with this topic - GAE should be included within this discussion
